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### North Carolina Community College State Board to Meet May 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> Via Telephone

RALEIGH – As a cost-cutting measure, the North Carolina State Board of Community Colleges will meet via teleconference on May 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup>. Agenda highlights include discussion by the Program Services Committee of the 2008 passing rates for nursing students within the NC Community College System, a legislative update by the Policy Committee, and the discussion and renewal of various service agreements by the Finance and Capital Needs Committee. The full board meeting begins Friday at 9 a.m. with the telephonic meeting originating in the State Board Room located in the Caswell Building at 200 West Jones Street.

The various committee meetings will take place via telephone beginning at 1:30 p.m. on Thursday, May 14<sup>th</sup>. Items of interest include a discussion by the Policy Committee ([agenda](#)) regarding the process for conducting sessions on the report studying the admission of undocumented students into North Carolina community colleges and developing an admission policy, and a 4 p.m. meeting of the Nominating Committee that will discuss the process and nominations for board chair and vice chair. As part of ongoing efforts by the State Board to contain costs, the May meeting will be conducted entirely by telephone with all committee meetings as well as the full board meeting originating from the Caswell Building at 200 West Jones Street. Anyone wishing to attend the one of the committee meetings or the State Board meeting should come to the Caswell Building.
