Subject: Ameritech Contract Meeting on February 5

You are invited to participate in a North Carolina Information Highway (NCIH) meeting on Thursday, February 5, 1998, from 1:00-3:00PM. The meeting will be for discussion about the Ameritech contract with NCCCS for the Data Automation Center (DAC). Ameritech representatives Matt Shill, Southeast Regional Manager, and Scott McCausland, Sales Representative, will be discussing product development for the Dynix and Horizon software. They will also present their proposal for the contract.

All colleges, not simply DAC member colleges, will be affected by issues involved in this contract, particularly in the areas of distance education and resource sharing.
