SUBJECT: GED Special Accommodation Forms and Spanish Tests

It has come to my attention that some of you are not using the current forms for students who have a physical or learning disability to request special test conditions or use special editions of the GED Tests.

For students with physical or emotional disabilities, refer to Appendix E3 and those students with specific learning disabilities and/or ADHD refer to Appendix E4 in the 1997 GED Examiner's Manual published by GED Testing Service.

Regarding the Spanish GED Tests, for those testing centers not using the computer scoring key disk, please send your examinee answer sheets to the Oklahoma Scoring Service for scoring. Because of the compromise in other regions of certain Spanish Test forms, hand scoring stencils are no longer available.
