SUBJECT: Tanning Facility Operator's Course

In North Carolina anyone operating a tanning facility business must meet certain compliance criteria established by the Division of Radiation Protection. These criteria require certification of individuals who operate tanning beds. To be certified, the tanning facility operators must take an approved tanning facility operator's course such as those offered by the North Carolina Community College System.

Carteret Community College will be hosting a Tanning Facility Operator's Train-the-Trainer certification course for instructors who will teach the tanning facility operator's courses. The course will be taught on Friday, March 13, 1998, from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m., in room 205 of the Main Building. The college is located at 3505 Arendell Street, Morehead City, NC. Instructors should have a background of formal course work in radiation biology, radiation protection, anatomy and physiology, and pathology; i.e., radiologic technologists, health physicists, etc. Gurney Mizell, RT-R, will conduct the course.
