Applicants to the EMI/Selena Scholarship Program must:

- Be a U. S. Citizen
- Be Hispanic
- Be a full-time sophomore at an accredited two-year college or technical school who plans to transfer to a four-year college or university and enroll full-time in the fall of 1999 in an undergraduate program leading to a bachelor's degree.
- Have a minimum 3.0 grade point average on a 4.0 scale.
