SUBJECT: Model Articulation Agreement

To enhance the transition of high school students to community colleges, the community college system is in the process of developing a model statewide articulation agreement, and your input is valuable. The document will reflect the many excellent practices that exist around our system with Tech Prep, Huskins Bill courses, and dual enrollment.

Please nominate experienced faculty and staff to serve on work teams to develop components of this articulation agreement. From your nominations, representatives from the community college system will be selected to meet with high school representatives to discuss and make recommendations for the articulation agreement. These meetings will occur in late October and early November in Raleigh. The System Office will reimburse at the state rate mileage costs for those traveling more than 50 miles and hotel costs for those traveling more than 200 miles.

Following the team meetings, a draft of the model articulation agreement will be sent to you for review and comment. A Steering Committee, composed of representatives from North Carolina Community College System and the Public School System, will review input received and revise the documents. A finalized articulation model reflecting best practices around the state will be available to you in the spring.

Thank you for your assistance in developing this model. Smooth articulation of high school students to our community colleges will benefit us all.
