RE: SAS Institute has Additional Unix™ Workstations to Donate

Deadline for Response: January 20, 1999

SAS Institute continues to be extremely generous to the North Carolina Community College System. Last month, SAS donated 200 Unix™ workstations and mass storage units, worth about \$150,000, to colleges which indicated an interest in the equipment. **SAS Institute has notified the System Office of their interest in donating an additional 150 workstations to our colleges. A few mass storage units may also be available on a first-come, first-served basis.** If you are interested in benefitting from SAS's generous offer, please let me know before Wednesday, January 20.

The workstations are model number HP 720. Each workstation runs at 50 MHZ and has two hard drives totaling 950 MB of memory. They come complete with a 19 inch color monitor, keyboard, mouse, and cabling. Please note, however, the operating system has been deleted from each of the workstations.
