SUBJECT: Articulation with the US Navy

At the request of the Presidents Association, we have been asked to develop model articulation agreements with the US Navy for use by colleges within the system. Initially, we hope to develop agreements in four program areas: electronics engineering, machinist, information technology, and electrician.

Curriculum work teams from each program area will be utilized to develop these agreements. We request that you nominate a faculty member from your institution to serve on each curriculum work team if you have the applicable program at your college. We will choose 7 to 10 faculty members from across the system to serve on each of these four work teams. Faculty members will be asked to devote one day to examine course competencies and provide expertise in the development of these agreements. We anticipate using a central location (Raleigh or Greensboro) to avoid overnight travel. Please use the enclosed form to nominate your faculty. **Completed forms should be returned to Stephen L. Athans no later than January 17, 2000.**

This is just another of our continuing efforts to make North Carolina's community colleges accessible to as many students as possible.
