The North Carolina Division of Motor Vehicles (NCDMV) has developed a *Commercial Motor Vehicle Safety Awareness* curriculum to help law enforcement agencies become more familiar with commercial motor vehicles. NCDMV has requested that this course be offered through the NC Community College System. Please review the attached memorandum from Captain W. T. Keel, NCDMV Enforcement.

The course *Commercial Motor Vehicle Safety Awareness* is designed as an 8-hour course and can be offered under course code *CJC 3998, Vehicle Stop Tactics*. A copy of the student lesson plan for the course is attached. NCDMV gives the college permission to reproduce this lesson plan for education/training purposes.

Instructors for the course must be certified to conduct North American Standard Vehicle Inspections by the Commercial Vehicle Safety Alliance and have detailed knowledge of the rules and regulations governing the Transportation Industry.
