SUBJECT: Child Care Projections

Please assess your child care resources and needs for the remainder of this academic year.

A number of colleges have reported significant numbers of currently enrolled students who will not be able to continue their enrollment without child care support. Since all of the North Carolina Community College System's state funded child care resources have been allocated to the colleges, the only possibility of providing support to these students will come from the redistribution of funds which might not be needed by the colleges. *Please be aware that the reallocation of these funds may be affected by the present state budget shortfall.* All funds are to be utilized by June 30, 2001.

If your college will not have need for all your allocated funds, the reversion of any excess resources may make it possible to provide support where it is needed. Your response to the attached questionnaire will help us in assessing both system-wide services and needs.
