SUBJECT: Unduplicated Headcount, 2002-03

All curriculum and continuing education registration data files for 2002-03 have been submitted by the colleges and uploaded to the data warehouse. You can now generate reports on unduplicated headcount for curriculum or continuing education for your college as a Skilled Knowledge Worker. In addition, using the EIS system you can download reports on all the colleges and the system that present data on unduplicated headcount in curriculum or continuing education. What is not possible since the implementation of the new Curriculum Student universe in 2001-02; however, is the ability to generate a total unduplicated headcount for the colleges or the system in the data warehouse.

Since the unduplicated total is a highly requested piece of information, I have prepared the attached Excel spreadsheet for your use. The spreadsheet contains three data columns by college and for the system. The first two columns present the unduplicated annual headcount for curriculum and continuing education, respectively. These data come straight from the data warehouse. The third column gives data on the total unduplicated annual headcount for each college and the system. These data were generated by downloading all student social security numbers to a flat file, reading the file into SAS and then unduplicating the data by college and for the system. These data are true unduplicated numbers.
