SUBJECT: Spanish and French GED Test

This is a reminder that December 31, 2003 was the last day to combine scores for the Spanish and French partial test takers. The new 2004 Spanish and French language GED will evaluate proficiency that is not assessed on the current test battery. Because of these changes, scores earned on the current tests cannot be combined with scores from the new tests.

Also, beginning in 2004, any candidates who take the test in a language other than English will receive a transcript that indicates the test was taken in that language.

The University of Texas Scoring Service will provide the scoring for the Spanish and French test until we are ready to score them at the System Office. Send the demographic forms and answer sheets to the scoring service as you did for the English 2002 test. I will notify you when we will be able to score the Spanish and French test at the System Office.
