SUBJECT: *Compensatory Education Program Regional Instructors' Training*

The Compensatory Education Program Regional Instructors' Training is provided at no cost; however, you must complete the enclosed registration form to indicate how many participants from your program will be attending and at which location. This year's regional training sessions will be conducted through a special project with the Center for Development and Learning/UNC-Chapel Hill (CDL/UNC-Chapel Hill). In addition to the regional training this year, the six-hours North Carolina Interventions (NCI) training required by Mental Health will be offered for all instructors who teach in community rehabilitation facilities (formerly called sheltered workshops). The same training will be offered at all three locations.

Space for the training is limited to 60 participants per training location. Space will be available to all Compensatory Education Program instructors on a "first come" basis.
