SUBJECT: Curriculum Review Committee Fall 2005 Meeting - Addendum

The Curriculum Review Committee (CRC) has the responsibility for maintaining and maximizing use of the Common Course Library (CCL). The committee has the authority for approving changes to the CCL, and it meets in the spring and fall to review requests that have been submitted by the colleges.

The Fall 2005 meeting was held on September 28, 2005. Numbered memorandum CC05-235, dated November 8, 2005, gave a detailed report of the CRC meeting. Two items disapproved at this meeting as new courses were FIP 229, Fire Behavior and Combustion, and FIP 277, Fire Related Human Behavior. The courses were disapproved due to the appearance of duplication in the course description. Upon receipt of revised course descriptions and supporting documentation, the CRC decided on November 30, 2005, to reverse its original decision. The courses have now been approved.
