SUBJECT: System Office Contract Relationship with WHY Y

For the past year, the North Carolina Community College System (NCCCS) has utilized telecourses from WHY Y, an independent educational vendor. Due to corporate ownership changes, the duplication and broadcasting rights in the licensing contract with NCCCS have changed. After several conversations between representatives in the System Office and WHY Y, it has been decided that the System Office will no longer pay for the telecourse licenses for this vendor effective Summer Semester 2007.

Currently, colleges are invoiced by this vendor for the student enrollment fees. In the future, if colleges choose to utilize telecourses from WHY Y, the colleges will also be responsible for the license fees and any additional duplication fees.
