This course introduces early childhood education and the role of the teacher in environments that encourage exploration and learning. Topics include professionalism, child growth and development, individuality, family, and culture. Upon completion, students should be able to identify and demonstrate knowledge of professional roles, major areas of child growth and development, and diverse families.

Proposed Revision: *Archive the Course*

Rationale of Requesting College: EDU 111 was developed in 1992 in cooperation with the Division of Child Development to be offered as a standardized course across the state. The Division provided the tests, handouts, audio-visuals, and other materials. The courses were revised in 1997, but have not been updated since that time. The course is no longer relevant to the field and is no longer supported by the division. The NC Institute for Early Childhood Professional Development, an advisory group to the Division, has asked that the courses no longer be offered. EDU 119 is more substantive in content and replaces both EDU 111 and EDU 112 in meeting Child Care Licensing requirements for teachers. EDU 119 articulates to most four year institutions and EDU 111 does not.

Topics include the learning environment, planning developmentally appropriate activities, positive guidance techniques, and health, safety, and nutrition standards. Upon completion, students should be able to demonstrate developmentally appropriate activities and positive guidance techniques and describe health/sanitation/nutrition practices that promote healthy environments for children.

Proposed Revision: *Archive the Course*

Rationale of Requesting College: EDU 112 was developed in 1992 in cooperation with the Division of Child Development to be offered as a standardized course across the state. The Division provided the tests, handouts, audio-visuals, and other materials. The courses were revised in 1997, but have not been updated since that time. The course is no longer relevant to the field and is no longer supported by the division. The NC Institute for Early Childhood Professional Development, an advisory group to the Division, has asked that the courses no longer be offered.
