Subject: Criminal Justice Distance Learning Courses

On March 22, 2000, I sent a memorandum to all Criminal Justice Program Directors (Number S00-015) to inform them of a Supervisory Certificate Program initiative that had been developed collaboratively with staff from North Carolina State University. The certificate consists of five courses; three from NCSU and two of the three courses found in the Associate in Arts Articulation Agreement in Criminal Justice. The courses from the articulation agreement are as follows:

CJC 111	Introduction to Criminal Justice	(3 SHC)
CJC 121	Law Enforcement Operations	(3 SHC)
CJC 141	Corrections	(3 SHC)

Students who have enrolled in the courses offered by NCSU as part of this certificate, have requested information as to which community colleges are offering the above listed courses using distance learning or are in the process of developing these courses.
