A number of community colleges have State Board approval to offer Basic Law Enforcement Training (BLET), CJC 100, as a curriculum program of study, C55120. This memorandum serves as a reminder to each of you to electronically file BLET, CJC 100, as a curriculum program of study, C55120, if you intend to offer it in Fall, 2000. The NC Community College System State Board approved the proposed curriculum standard at their May 19, 2000 meeting. The filing deadline for all programs of study has been extended until Monday, July 17, 2000.

The currently approved BLET program of study is not in effect for Fall, 2000 due to mandated changes approved by the NC Criminal Justice Education and Training Standards Commission and NC Sheriffs' Education and Training Standards Commission.
