SUBJECT: Basic Law Enforcement Training (BLET) Hours for Training

In response to requests to clarify the allowable number of hours for Basic Law Enforcement Training (BLET) training offered through continuing education programs we are submitting the following for clarification. This response is based on discussions with colleges, the North Carolina Department of Justice (NCDOJ), and North Carolina Community College System Continuing Education, Student and Academic Services Division, and Program Audit Services Section staff members.

- ♦ □ BLET training programs must offer the course content as mandated and set by the NC Criminal Justice Education and Training Standards Commission and the North Carolina Sheriffs Education and Training Commission in the required blocks of instruction.
- ♦ □ A college must offer the minimum number of hours for BLET training as mandated and set by the NC Criminal Justice Education and Training Standards Commission and the North Carolina Sheriffs Education and Training Commission to cover the required blocks of instruction.
- ♦ □ A college may not exceed the maximum number of hours allowed for the course, CJC 3938, Basic Law Enforcement Training (BLET), as listed on the Continuing Education Master Course List.
