**SUBJECT:** HRD – CAREER START Project Fiscal Year 2006-07

We are pleased to inform you that your college has been awarded federal funding for the HRD project CAREER START. This project is effective July 1, 2006 through June 30, 2007 and will be processed through the DCC2-112 report in purpose 351. To activate this project, the college must submit a form 104 to Tangi Crotts by **Monday, November 13** as listed on the attached spread sheet with the following three pieces:

1. Allocating the federal funds in purpose 351.
2. Reverting the required match from purpose 310 (Occupational Education).
3. Allotting the required match reverted from 310 to purpose 351.

If the college cannot meet the required match in full, partial federal funding will be available up to the matchable amount the college can sustain. Colleges approved to purchase equipment must first establish the full budget in purpose 351 and submit a separate budget transfer form 104 moving budget from purpose 351 to 920.

Current operating expenditures must be recorded with vocational code 80, and capital outlay expenditures must be recorded with vocational code 69 in a separate department/cost center/unit to track the program's activity. This report will be requested with your June 30 DCC2-112 report.
