While each community college continues to provide traditional criminal justice training services within its service area, the CJRCC mission is to identify and address the unique needs and levels of education and training not currently being provided.

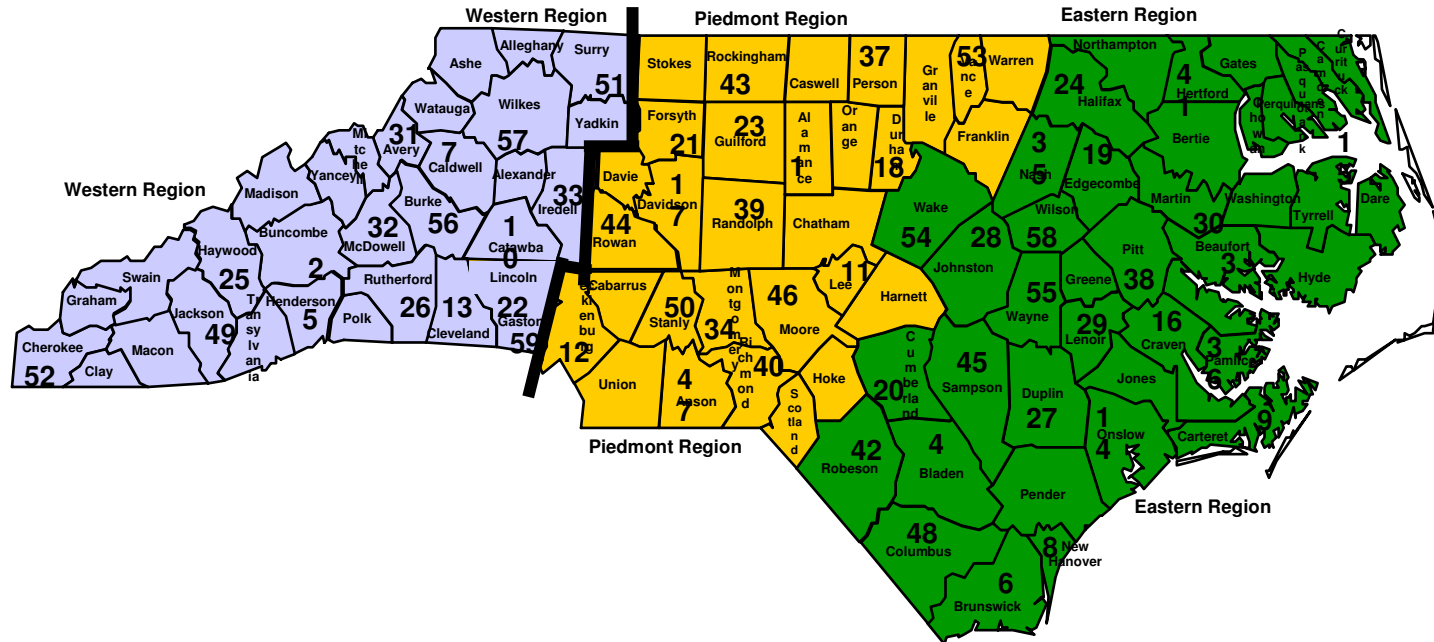

- to respond to unique education and training needs not currently being addressed, including mandated training when the demand of the region is not being met;
- to serve as an information center concerning innovations and changes in education and training;
- to establish cooperative planning and coordination of training with other agencies, colleges and regional coordinating centers to facilitate more efficient utilization of education and training resources;
- to disseminate advanced law enforcement education and training information;
- to develop advanced instructional resources through tailored train-the-trainer programs; and
