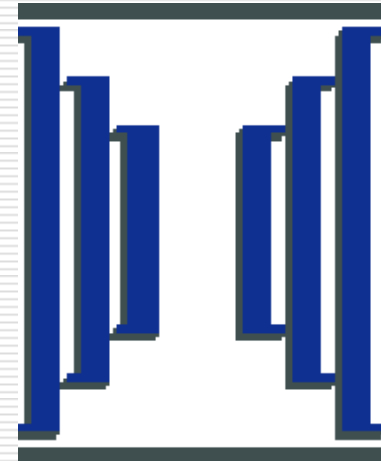

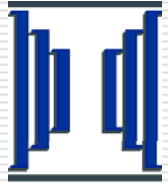

2008-2009 AUDIT SERVICES UPDATE

- CC05-232, *Basic Law Enforcement Training (BLET) Update – Curriculum and Continuing Education*
 - Effective January 2006, the Criminal Justice Education and Training Standards Commission increased the mandatory minimum hours for the state's Basic Law Enforcement Training (BLET) program from 602 to 618.
 - Continuing Education – CJC 3938 and, Curriculum – CJC 100 – courses must comply with the Commission's revised minimum standard of 618 contact hours.

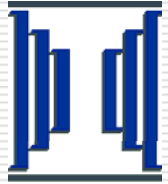

2008-2009 AUDIT SERVICES UPDATE

- CC03-185, *Community College Calendar*
 - For courses scheduled to meet during multiple academic terms, the following applies:
 - 1) For courses that report membership hours, if 70% of a course is scheduled for fall and spring terms, the FTE shall be reported in the term the census date occurs.



2008-2009 AUDIT SERVICES UPDATE

CC03-185, *Community College Calendar, Cont.*

2) For courses that report membership hours, if a course is scheduled to meet during all three terms the FTE may be reported in the fall or spring term provided 70% or more of the course meeting dates are scheduled in a combination of fall and spring terms. The FTE must be reported in the term the census date occurs.



2008-2009 AUDIT SERVICES UPDATE

- ❑ CC03-185, *Community College Calendar*, Cont.
 - 3) If the census date of a course that reports membership hours occurs during the summer term, but 70% or more of the **course meetings** occur during fall and spring terms, the course must be reported in the fall reporting period.
 - 4) For courses that report contact hours, use the ending date of the course to determine the reporting term.



2007-2008 AUDIT SERVICES UPDATE

- Documentation needed to conduct the annual audit review:
 - Copy of letters of sponsorship and/or receipted tuition

 - Copy of Pre/Post Delivery approval letter from NCDNJ Criminal Justice Standards Division

- Documentation needed to conduct the annual audit review cont.:
 - Copy of accreditation from NCDOJ Criminal Justice Standards Division

 - Copy of Pre and Post Delivery

CJC In Service Training

Tuition or Registration Fee Waiver

- General Statute 115D-5(b)

“...the State Board of Community Colleges may provide by general and uniform regulations for waiver of tuition and registration fees...for training courses for volunteer firemen, local fire department personnel, volunteer rescue and lifesaving department personnel.”



CJC In Service Training

- ❑ Title 23 NCAC 02D.0203(a)(5)(A) *Fees for Extension Programs*

(5) “Registration Fee Waivers: (A) Special Extension Training Programs. No registration fees shall be charged students enrolling for special extension training programs that **directly relate to job performance** set forth in G.S. 115D-5(b).”



CJC In Service Training

CC08-010 *Tuition and Fee Waivers Clarification*

The fee waiver policy is applicable to campus and company police departments only if they meet one of the following:

- The definition of “employer” as defined by G.S. 115B-1(1) to be “The State of North Carolina and its departments, agencies, and institutions; or a county, city, town, or other political subdivision of the State.”



CJC In Service Training

CC08-010 *Tuition and Fee Waivers Clarification cont.*

- When the local board of trustees of any college or university, who qualifies as a campus police agency enters into a mutual aid agreement to designate the campus police as a municipal police department. This agreement must be approved by the governing board of a municipality or with the consent of the county sheriff. For more details, see G.S. 74E-6(d) or G.S. 115D-21.1.



CJC In Service Training

CC08-010 *Tuition and Fee Waivers Clarification cont.*

- If the department is listed on the local Emergency Operations Plan (EOP) as essential personnel in an emergency situation.

Otherwise, law enforcement officers who are classified as campus or company police are employed by a non-governmental or private entity **are not** eligible for fee waivers.
