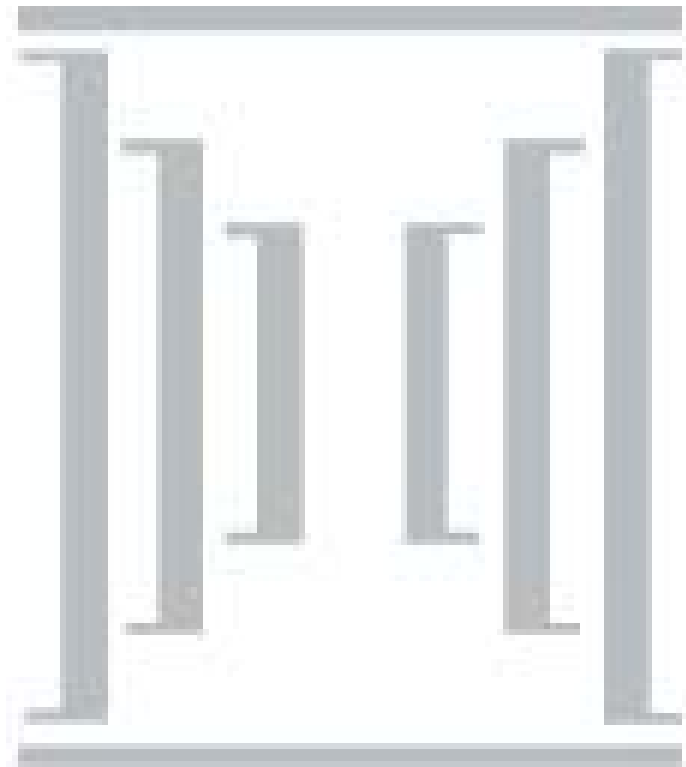

Achieving Student Success by Income Status (Fall 2002 and 2004 Cohorts)

Methodology

- Curriculum student records from CRPFAR (Curriculum Registration, Progress, and Financial Aid Report) data files for Fall 2002, and Fall 2004
- Curriculum students seeking associate degree, certificate, and diploma, enrolled for the first time in the fall 2002 and fall 2004 (Transitional students were excluded from the cohorts.)
- Income status was determined by whether a student received Pell Grant or not (low-income vs. non low-income)

Student Success Measures

1. First-Year Intermediate Milestones
 - Persisted fall to spring
 - Passed 80% or more of courses attempted: Letter grades A, B, C, and D were considered as passing grades.
 - First-year credit milestone: Earned 24 or more credit hours for full-time students/ earned 18 or more credit hours for part-time students.
2. Second-Year Intermediate Milestones
 - Persisted fall to fall
 - Enrolled in developmental education math courses by year 2 (Associate degree-seeking students only)
 - Passed developmental education math courses by year 2 (Associate degree-seeking students only) — course letter grade D or better
 - Achieved the two year credit hour milestone — earned 42 or more credit hours for full-time students / earned 24 or more credit hours for part-time students
3. Third-Year Intermediate Milestones
 - Passed gatekeeper English or higher by year 3 — ENG 111 (Expository Writing) or higher
 - Passed gatekeeper math or higher by year 3 — MAT 151 (Statistics I), MAT 161 (College Algebra), and MAT 171 (Pre-calculus Algebra) or higher: College transfer students only
4. Student Success Outcomes (Four-year outcomes for '02 and '04 cohorts; six-year outcomes for '02 cohort)
 - Earned award without transfer
 - Transferred without award
 - Still enrolled with 30 or more credit hours
