**I. Program Planning**

Coastal Carolina Community College (CCCC) is seeking approval for the Criminal Justice Technology/Financial Crime/Computer Fraud (A5518B) program to begin Fall 2008. The planning area is defined as the college's service area of Onslow County.

All colleges were notified of the planning process for this program and a planning meeting was held. The college conducted an employment availability survey within the planning area:

Currently:	30 employment positions available
1st graduating class:	38 employment positions available
2nd graduating class:	44 employment positions available

The average entry-level salary is \$38,500 per year.

**II. Impact of the Proposed Program on Other Programs**

Three community colleges are approved to offer this program. Impact Assessment forms were sent to each of these colleges. No negative impact responses were received.

**III. Feasibility Plan**

Coastal Carolina Community College is approved to offer the Criminal Justice Technology program; therefore, a separate feasibility study is not required for the concentration.
