The 2009-2010 State Financial Aid Allocation Tables
for
Targeted Assistance (High Demand but Low Enrollment Programs)
and
Less than Half-time Enrolled Students

The 2009–2010 North Carolina Community College Targeted Assistance program will provide \$500,000 to colleges for students to enroll in high demand but Low Enrollment programs. These funds are authorized by G.S. 115D-40.1 and were approved originally by the State Board on May 17, 2002. The attached table provides the amount of Targeted Assistance funds for each college. Targeted Assistance funds are allocated based upon a \$1,000 base plus a percentage of remaining funds based upon the Pell Grants awarded by each college in 2007-2008.

The 2009-2010 Less Than Half-time Enrolled Students Program will provide \$262,806 to colleges for students who are enrolled less than six (6) semester hours in curriculum programs. The State Board approved the policy regulating these funds in July 2003. Less than Half-time Enrolled Students funds are also allocated based upon a \$1,000 base plus a percentage of the remaining funds based upon the Pell Grants awarded by each college in 2007-2008.

Funds for these programs are available from the allocation of need-based funds provided on a recurring basis by the NC General Assembly and are contingent upon the approval of the General Assembly.
