I. Program Planning

Stanly Community College (SCC) is seeking approval for a Networking Technology (C25340) certificate program to begin Fall 2010 at Albemarle Correctional Institution #4580

Based on 2010 North Carolina Employment Security Commission data, wages for entry-level computer support technicians or retail sales personnel range from \$7.50 to \$12.70 per hour. Average wages range from \$11.00 to \$18.00 per hour, and higher with experience.

II. Impact of the Proposed Program on Other Programs

This program will replace the Computer Engineering Technology (C40160) certificate program currently being offered at the prison.

III. Feasibility Plan

Albemarle Correctional Institution has allocated instructional space that is appropriate for the program, and local prison officials are committed to providing inmate students who meet the educational requirements of the program.

Projected enrollment, based on program capacity:

1st class:	15 full-time	0 part-time
2nd class:	15 full-time	0 part-time

No new personnel costs are associated with the start-up of this program since the college will use the instructional position from the Computer Engineering Technology program that is being phased out. Start-up costs for equipment, supplies, and textbooks are estimated at \$7,000. The Department of Correction will assist with the cost of textbooks. The funds necessary to operate the program will come from regular budget FTE.
