**I. Program Planning**

Vance-Granville Community College (VGCC) is seeking approval for two certificate programs (C55200) under the Culinary Technology (A55200) program, to begin Fall 2010 at the Low Security Correctional Institution (LSCI) in Butner.

According to the U.S. Department of Labor (O\*NET), there will be a 24% increase in the demand for food-preparation workers in NC between 2006 and 2016, with the median salary being \$16,800 per year. In addition, there will be a 13% increase in demand for bakers during the same time period, with the median salary being \$21,800 per year. Earnings can rise to \$23,900 and \$31,100, respectively, depending on experience, skill, and geographic location.

**III. Feasibility Plan**

LCSI has allocated instructional space that is appropriate for the Culinary certificate programs, and local prison officials have committed to providing inmate students who meet the educational requirements of the program.

Projected enrollment, based on program capacity:

1st class:	20 full-time	0 part-time
2nd class:	20 full-time	0 part-time

LCSI will purchase tools, equipment, and instructional resources to start the program, with the college providing \$3,500.00 for supplies and equipment in the first year. The college and the prison will share initial instructor costs, with VGCC's portion being approximately \$8,400. In subsequent years, the college will provide all instructor costs, at approximately \$16,840 per year, and a portion of the instructional supplies, at \$3,500 per year. The prison will continue to be responsible for all other program costs. The funds necessary to operate the program will come from regular budget FTE. No additional allocation of funds will be necessary to support the program.
