

STATE BOARD OF COMMUNITY COLLEGES

System Office Contract Report as of December 31, 2010

State Board Requirement: On October 16, 2009, the State Board approved an increase to the authority of the System President to sign and execute contracts without prior State Board approval, from a \$25,000 to a \$50,000 delegation to become effective January 1, 2010. Continuing on an action by the State Board on August 19, 2005, these contracts are to be presented "For Information" to the Finance and Capital Needs Committee on a semi-annual basis.

Summary of Report: During the reporting period of July 1, 2010 through December 31, 2010, twenty-eight contracts were approved below the \$50,000 delegation and are listed in this report. The total of these contracts is \$313,888 of which \$187,988 (60%) are funded by federal or private grants or registration fees.

Under the previous delegation of \$25,000 and above, 6 of these 28 contracts would have required State Board approval.

Of the 28 contracts, 6 contracts were issued to community colleges.

Academic & Student Services issued 17 contracts.

Office of the President issued 3 contracts.

Technology & Workforce Development issued 8 contracts.
