CAPTIVE/CO-OPTED GROUPS**

**Expedited Approval for Prison Continuing Education Courses of Instruction**

The State Board is asked to approve the attached list of Continuing Education courses for offering to inmates at Department of Correction (DOC) prison facilities, as a result of recent legislative action. (See Session Law 2011-45 referenced below.\*)

The Board is further asked to grant colleges retroactive approval to July 1, 2011, since this is the effective date of the mandated changes.

Background Information:

- The Legislature eliminated the tuition and registration fee waiver for prison inmates and transferred funds to DOC to support direct payment to colleges for inmates enrolled in community college courses at state prisons, effective July 1, 2011. The waiver had been the State's mechanism for paying for the enrollment of selected inmates in Curriculum and Continuing Education courses since the early 1970's. (The legislation did not affect FTE funding related to prison education, only the manner in which inmates' enrollment charges are paid.)
- DOC and Community Colleges have a long-standing partnership for providing basic education and/or occupational skills training to approximately 10% of the inmate population at any given time. It is DOC's intent to preserve as much programming as possible, within the parameters set by the Legislature. To that end, DOC determined it cannot fund curriculum tuition for inmates, with the exception of tuition for Foodservice Technology, Cosmetology, and Barbering. Colleges offering other Curriculum programs at state prisons were asked to convert all offerings to Continuing Education occupational skills training. The attached course list is the result of this conversion.
- DOC has established the following priorities for prison education: Basic Skills and/or Human Resources Development (HRD); courses that support Correction Enterprises, the Inmate Construction Program or Prison Operations; and vocational/occupational skills training. All requested courses fall within these priorities.

**COMMUNITY COLLEGE TUITION WAIVERS**

**SECTION 8.12.(a)** G.S. 115D-5(b) reads as rewritten: "... The State Board of Community Colleges may provide by general and uniform regulations for waiver of tuition and registration fees for the following: ~~(14) Prison inmates.~~"

**SECTION 8.12.(c)** The Community Colleges System Office shall transfer funds appropriated for curriculum and continuing education instruction to the Department of Correction. The Department of Correction shall use these funds to pay tuition and fees for prisoners.
