**Terminations**

The following community colleges requested and received approval to terminate curriculum programs as listed:

**Caldwell Community College and Technical Institute**

**Business Administration/Electronic Commerce (A2512I)**

College Rationale: Low Enrollment: Inability of students to find employment in service area.

Ending Term: Fall 2009

**Computed Tomography & Magnetic Resonance Imaging  
Technology (D45200)**

College Rationale: Low Enrollment: North Carolina does not have regulations requiring formal training for advanced certification in Computed Tomography & Magnetic Resonance Imaging Technology (CT/MRI). Students are not willing to delay employment for one or two semesters to acquire skills that are available through on-the-job training.

Ending Term: Fall 2009

**Furniture Upholstery (Diploma) (D50220)**

College Rationale: Low Enrollment: There is no demand in the county for upholstering skills as furniture plants have closed their doors resulting in low program enrollment.

Ending Term: Fall 2009

**Heavy Equipment and Transport Technology (A60240)**

College Rationale: No Enrollment: Low demand in the county coupled with high cost to purchase the latest diagnostic equipment caused the program to suffer resulting in low enrollment.

Ending Term: Fall 2009

**Industrial Management Technology (D50260)**

College Rationale: No Enrollment: Low demand in the county. The county is moving away from an industrial based workforce to service related industries. This resulted in low program enrollment.

Ending Term: Fall 2009

**Machining Technology (A50300)**

College Rationale: No Enrollment: As companies have shut down or relocated facilities the county no longer has the need or demand for machinists. This resulted in low program enrollment.

Ending Term: Fall 2009

**Machining Technology/Tool, Die, and Mold Making (A5030A)**

College Rationale: No Enrollment: As companies have shut down or relocated facilities the county no longer has the need or demand for machinists. This resulted in low program enrollment.

Ending Term: Fall 2009

**Real Estate (A25400)**

College Rationale: Low Enrollment: The college currently meets the local demand for real estate through continuing education.

Ending Term: Fall 2009

**Surveying Technology (A40380)**

College Rationale: No Enrollment: There is no demand in the county for surveyors, as jobs are few, resulting in low program enrollment.

Ending Term: Fall 2009

**Welding Technology (A50420)**

College Rationale: Low Enrollment: There is low demand in the county for welders, as jobs are few, resulting in low program enrollment. The college plans to move the program to continuing education.

Ending Term: Fall 2009
