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State Board of Community Colleges to Meet

Admissions Policy Expected to be Taken up by Full Board

RALEIGH – The State Board of Community Colleges will hold its regularly scheduled monthly meeting Thursday and Friday, September 17 and 18.

Items on the agenda include an admissions policy related to undocumented immigrants, the approval of budget allocations for six BioNetwork centers, and the approval of new course offerings.

The various committees of the State Board will meet on Thursday, September 17 beginning at 1:30 p.m. The Policy Committee will meet Thursday at 1:30 p.m. and will take up the issue of undocumented immigrant admissions. If the current [policy recommendation](#) is voted out of committee favorably, it will then go before the full Board for discussion and possibly a vote on Friday. The full Board will convene Friday, September 18 at 9 a.m. in the State Board Room. All meetings will take place at the Caswell Building, 200 West Jones Street, Raleigh.
