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State Board of Community Colleges to Meet

RALEIGH – The State Board of Community Colleges will hold its regularly scheduled monthly meeting Thursday and Friday, August 19 and 20, 2010. The meeting will begin Thursday at 12 p.m. with an issues luncheon presentation, “NC Community Colleges – A Virtual Learning Community.”

Committee meetings begin Thursday at 1:30 p.m. The Policy Committee will hear a presentation of all 2010 legislation impacting North Carolina’s community colleges. The Program Services Committee is scheduled to pass a resolution to endorse the efforts of the State Board of Education in adopting the Common Core National Standards, which ensures that students graduating from high school are career and college ready. The Finance and Capital Needs Committee is scheduled to approve the allocation of grant money to support community college Minority Male Mentoring programs. This program will be the subject of a brief combined meeting of the Program Services and Finance and Capital Needs Committees beginning at 1:30 p.m.

The full Board will convene Friday at 9 a.m. All meetings are open to the public and take place in the Caswell Building at 200 W Jones St. in Raleigh. A full agenda is attached.
