State Board of Community Colleges to Meet

RALEIGH – The State Board of Community Colleges will hold its regularly scheduled monthly meeting Thursday, September 16, 2010. In an effort to maximize resources, the meeting will be held during one day, rather than the traditional two-day schedule.

The day will begin at 9:30 a.m. with the first of five committee meetings. The Policy Committee will continue the rule making process to adopt NCAC 23 02C .0213, “School Absence for Religious Observances”, as directed by G.S. 115C-379 from the 2010 Legislative Session. The Program Services Committee has several program and course applications to approve in both curriculum and continuing education areas. The Finance and Capital Needs Committee will hear a summary of 2009-10 State Financial Aid Programs for Community College Students, which, for the 2009-10 year, includes an increase of nearly 1,000 students receiving community college grants.

An issues luncheon presentation, “National Association of Manufacturing Endorsed Certification System” will begin at 12 p.m. Speakers include Dr. R. Scott Ralls, NC Community College System President; Emily DeRocco, President of the Manufacturing Institute with the National Association of Manufacturers in Washington, D.C.; Dr. Gary Green, President of Forsyth Technical Community College; and Dr. Sharon Morrissey, NC Community College System Senior Vice President and Chief Academic Officer. Forsyth Technical Community College in Winston-Salem is one of four community colleges in the nation leading the development and deployment of the Manufacturing Skills Certification System that allows students to qualify for multiple, nationally recognized credentials as they work toward an associate degree in advanced manufacturing.

The State Board meeting will convene at 1:45 p.m. All meetings are open to the public and take place in the Caswell Building at 200 W Jones St. in Raleigh. A full agenda is attached.
