RALEIGH – The State Board of Community Colleges will hold its regularly scheduled monthly meeting on February 18 and 19, 2010. The meeting will begin on Thursday, February 18 at 12 p.m. with an issues luncheon and presentation on developmental education within the NC Community College System.

Meeting highlights include an overview of the system’s unprecedented enrollment growth by the Finance and Capital Needs Committee and a review by the Policy Committee of public comments received on the proposed amendment to 23 N.C.A.C. 02C .0301- “Admission to Colleges.”

The full Board will convene Friday, February 19 at 9 a.m. All meetings will take place in the Caswell Building at 200 W Jones Street in Raleigh.
