Nine Members of State Board to Take Oath of Office *Election of Officers Slated*

RALEIGH – The State Board of Community Colleges will welcome five new and four re-appointed members when it convenes on July 16 and 17, the largest class of the State Board to take the oath of office. Governor Bev Perdue is expected to administer the oath to her appointees as well as the North Carolina Comprehensive Community College Student Government Association (N4CSGA) President, an ex-officio board member. Both the Senate and the House are appointing or re-appointing two members each.

Established in 1981, the State Board of Community Colleges is made up of 21 voting members. Ten are appointed by the governor, four are appointed by the House and four appointed by the Senate for six-year terms. Three members are ex-officio by virtue of their position: the Lt. Governor, the State Treasurer and the N4CSGA President.

The various committees of the State Board will meet Thursday, July 16 beginning at 1:30 p.m. Highlights include a presentation to the Program Services Committee on the Study of Associate Degree Nursing Success and how its recommendations might increase future passing rates for nursing graduates within the NC Community College System and discussion of various service agreements by the Finance and Capital Needs Committee. The Policy Committee will hear a legislative update and will discuss licensures of two new proprietary schools offering courses in medical billing/coding and medical assisting.

The full Board meeting will convene Friday, July 17 at 9 a.m. in the State Board Room at 200 West Jones Street in Raleigh and will begin with the election of chair and vice-chair to two-year terms, respectively, followed by the formal swearing in of both new and re-appointees to the State Board.
