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State Board of Community Colleges to Meet *NC Community Colleges Celebrate Excellence*

RALEIGH – The State Board of Community Colleges will hold his regularly scheduled monthly meeting Thursday and Friday, April 14 and 15, 2011.

Committee meetings begin Thursday at 8:30 a.m. The Policy Committee is scheduled to take action on the approval of two proprietary school licensures. The Program Services Committee will discuss Basic Skills federal and state performance measures. The Finance and Capital needs committee will hear an update on the state budget process.

Following the morning's committee meetings, the State Board of Community Colleges and representatives from all 58 community colleges will attend the NC Community Colleges Excellence Event awards luncheon, "The Great Within the 58," Thursday at 12:30 p.m. at the Jane S. McKimmon Center in Raleigh. The event is a celebration of excellence honoring students including Academic Excellence Award recipients from each college, the Governor Robert W. Scott Student Leadership Award recipient and the Dallas Herring Achievement Award recipient. The event will also honor Distinguished Partners in Excellence, Staff of the Year, Excellence in Teaching, President of the Year and the prestigious I.E. Ready Award recipient, the highest honor bestowed by the State Board of Community Colleges. This event is supported through non-state funds.

Remaining committee meetings will resume at the Jane S. McKimmon Center at 2:30 p.m. following the event.
