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State Board of Community Colleges to Meet

RALEIGH – The State Board of Community Colleges will hold its regularly scheduled monthly meeting Thursday and Friday, February 17 and 18, 2011. The meeting will begin Thursday at 12 p.m. with an issues luncheon, “Success, Access and Completion – Target 2020 Democracy 2.0 Summit Update,” a roundtable discussion featuring N.C. community college students who participated in the Democracy 2.0 Summit in Charlotte.

Committee meetings will begin Thursday at 1:30 p.m. The Policy Committee will hear an update on legislative advocacy activities. The Program Services Committee is expected to take action on revisions to Small Business Center Network guidelines that will enhance program structures and decrease barriers to continuing education and curriculum entrepreneurship programs. The Finance and Capital Needs Committee is scheduled to take action on a service agreement with Forsyth Technical Community College to assist colleges in implementing the National Association of Manufacturing Certification System, funded by Duke Energy’s Community and Technical College Grant Program.

The full Board will convene Friday at 9 a.m. All meetings are open to the public and will take place in the Caswell Building, 200 West Jones Street in Raleigh. A full agenda is attached.
