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State Board of Community Colleges to Meet

RALEIGH – The State Board of Community Colleges will hold its regularly scheduled monthly meeting Thursday and Friday, January 20 and 21, 2011. The meeting will begin Thursday at 12 p.m. with an issues luncheon.

Committee meetings begin Thursday at 1:30 p.m. The Policy Committee is expected to discuss three policies, including a health and safety exception to 23 N.C.A.C. 02C .0301, "Admission to Colleges." The Program Services Committee will review program applications and terminations approved by the System President. The Financial and Capital Needs Committee will take action on the allocation of Developmental Education Math Redesign Grants, an initiative funded by the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation to improve and expand remedial programs.

The full Board will convene Friday at 9 a.m. All meetings are open to the public and will take place at the Caswell Building on 200 W. Jones Street in Raleigh. A full agenda is attached.
