RALEIGH – The State Board of Community Colleges will hold its annual planning and monthly meetings at Rowan-Cabarrus Community College’s Kannapolis location on the N.C. Research Campus. The planning session will begin Wednesday, October 19 at 11 a.m. and will continue through Thursday morning.
