### **State Board of Proprietary Schools to Meet**

RALEIGH – The State Board of Proprietary Schools will hold his first meeting, Tuesday, January 3, at 2 p.m.

During the 2011-12 legislative session, the North Carolina General Assembly passed [SL 2011-308](#) establishing the State Board of Proprietary Schools as of January 1, 2012. The Board is responsible for oversight of operations concerned with the licensing of certain for-profit postsecondary educational institutions offering non-degree programs to adult citizens in North Carolina and not licensed by any other State authority. The State Board of Proprietary Schools will make recommendations for licensure of these institutions to the State Board of Community Colleges, which retains this licensing authority by state law.

The State Board of Proprietary Schools will meet in the Caswell Building. A complete agenda is attached.
