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State Board of Community Colleges to Meet

RALEIGH – The State Board of Community Colleges will hold its regularly scheduled meeting August 18 and 19, 2011. The meeting will begin Thursday at 12 p.m. with an issues luncheon presentation, “Completion by Design,” a five-year program sponsored by the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation to significantly increase completion and graduation rates for low-income students under age 26. The initiative will be lead by Guilford Technical Community College and includes four partner colleges, Central Piedmont Community College, Davidson County Community College, Martin Community College and Wake Technical Community College.

Committee meetings begin Thursday at 1:30 p.m. The Policy Committee will take action on the State Board of Community Colleges’ rule-making process. The Program Services Committee will review the 2010-11 Customized Training Annual Report. The Finance and Capital Needs Committee will take action on various allocations of funds including the allocation of 2010-11 Minority Male Mentoring grants.

The full Board will convene Friday at 9 a.m. and will include a presentation on NC Community Colleges’ new financial literacy project, “Advanced Money Management.” The project was conducted in partnership with the State Treasurer’s Office, the State Education Assistance Authority and the College Foundation of North Carolina, and is designed to assist students with making informed decisions regarding financial aid options and debt management.

All meetings take place in the Caswell Building at 200 W. Jones Street in Raleigh. A full agenda is attached.
