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State Board of Community Colleges to Meet

RALEIGH – The State Board of Community Colleges will hold its monthly meeting Thursday and Friday, January 19 and 20, 2012, with an orientation for new Board members scheduled for Wednesday, January 18, beginning at 9 a.m.

The Board meeting will begin Thursday at 12 p.m. with an issues luncheon presentation, “Global Education in the North Carolina Community College System.” The presentation will be lead by Dr. Tracey Ivey, Chair, NC Community College System Global Learner Consortium and Mr. Roger Dostall, Southeast Region Representative, NC Community College System Global Learner Consortium.

Committee meetings will follow the issues luncheon at 1:30 p.m. The Policy Committee will hear an interim update on legislative committees. The Program Services Committee will discuss the 2012-14 Curriculum Improvement Project. The Finance and Capital Needs Committee is slated to take action on the allocation of funds for several initiatives including the North Carolina Space Grant and the implementation of the National Association of Manufacturing endorsed certification system.

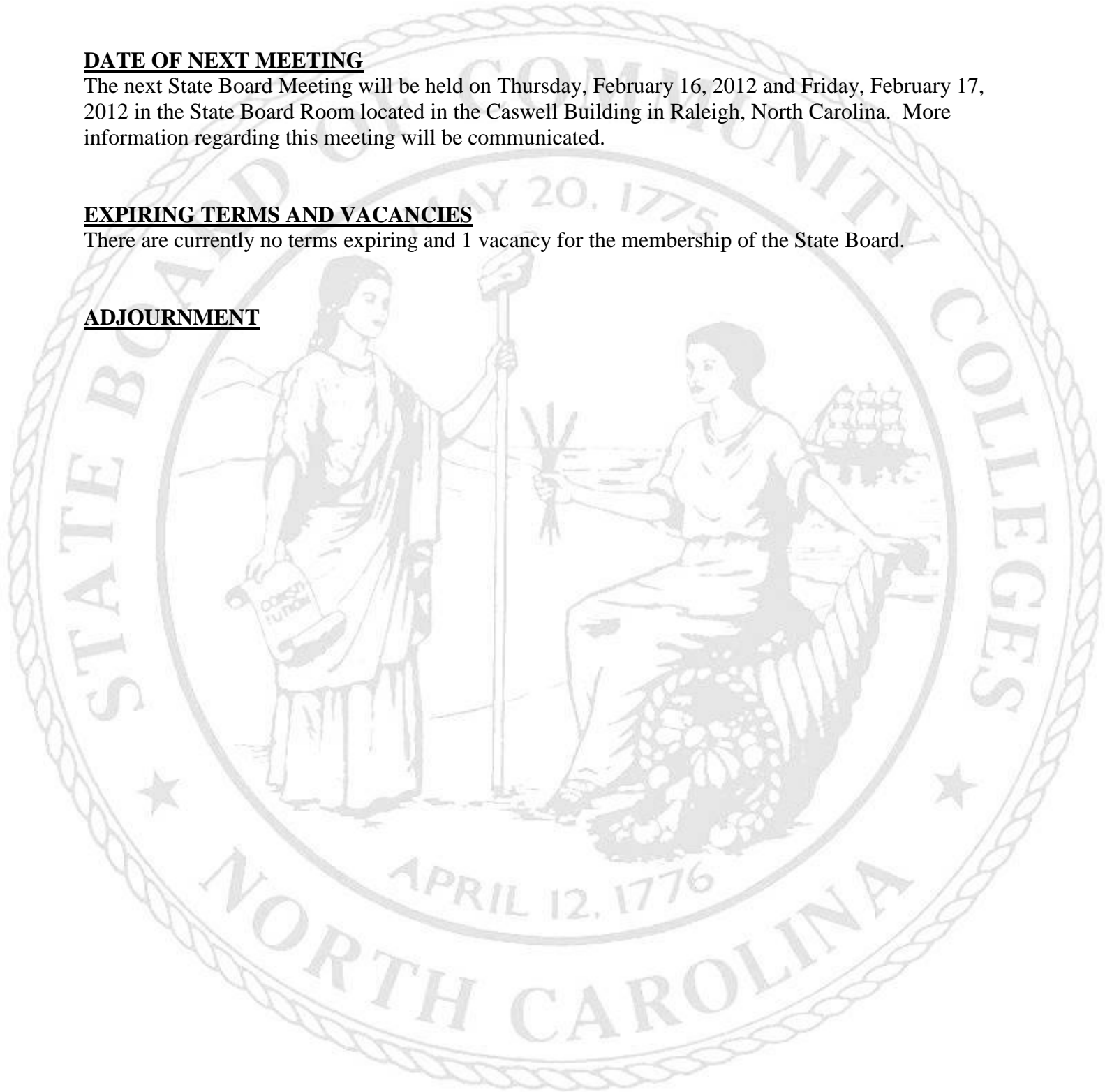
DATE OF NEXT MEETING
