| EMS 4500 | EMS Education & Admin Level II | 22 | L15 – Emergency Management Services | 3 |

Description: This course will prepare individuals to be knowledgeable in areas of EMS course administration, planning, coordination and delivery; curriculum development; staff/instructor supervision; and academic institutional accreditation. Course content will include identifying teaching and learning outcome measures and validating graduate outcome measures as required by licensing and certification agencies. This course is one requirement of the North Carolina Office of EMS to become a Level II EMS instructor.

Requesting College or Agency: NCCCS EMS Advisory Board with support from OEMS

| EMS 4501 | Educ. & Admin Train-the-Trainer | 6 | L15 – Emergency Management Services | 3 |

Description: This course is designed to provide the information and processes necessary to be eligible to teach the EMS Education and Administration Level II course. Pre-requisites: Student must be a NC OEMS credentialed Level II Paramedic instructor and have 2 years of experience as a NC OEMS Level II Paramedic Program Director/Coordinator of an CAAHEP-accredited EMS Educational Institution or 5 years as a NC OEMS Level II Paramedic Program Director/Coordinator of a non-CAAHEP-accredited EMS Educational Institution.

Rationale:

These courses are proposed by the NCCCS EMS Advisory Committee in collaboration with the NC Office of Emergency Medical Services for the purpose of updating courses/processes for instructor development that align with changes to national and state EMS rules and guidelines that were effective January 2017.
