Prerequisites: ICS-100, ICS-200, ICS-700, and ICS-800. This course must follow all current Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and NC Emergency Management (NCEM) guidelines.

Prerequisites: ICS-100, ICS-200, ICS-300, ICS-700, and ICS-800. This course must follow all current Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and NC Emergency Management (NCEM) guidelines.
