Allocations for Integrated English Literacy and Civics Education Programs
FY 2017-18

Request: The State Board is requested to approve allocations for twenty-seven Integrated English Literacy and Civics Education (IELCE) Programs in the amount of \$1,090,460.

These programs are funded under Section 243 of the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) for Integrated English Literacy and Civics Education (IELCE). IELCE programs must be provided in combination with integrated education and training activities and designed to: (1) prepare adult English language learners for, and place in, unsubsidized employment in in-demand industries and occupations that lead to economic self-sufficiency; and (2) integrate with the local workforce development system and its functions to carry out the activities of the program.

Method of Allocation: For the 2017-18 program year, based on approval from the United States Department of Education, the System Office announced a continuation of the funding for Integrated English Literacy and Civics Education Programs. Only those programs funded for implementation in 2016-17 were eligible for continuation funding. The application process was open to currently funded community colleges and community-based organizations (CBOs).
