

**STATE BOARD OF COMMUNITY COLLEGES**  
**Allocation for Hurricane Florence Enrollment (FTE) Losses**  
**FY 2019-20**

**Request:** The State Board is asked to approve the allocation of \$6,400,000 to be allocated to nineteen community colleges with full-time equivalent (FTE) enrollment losses as a result of Hurricane Florence.

**Background:** On September 18, 2019, the North Carolina General Assembly enacted Session Law 2019-224, the 2019 Disaster Recovery Act consistent with the provisions of House Bill 966 (the 2019 Appropriations Act which has not yet been enacted into law). This act applies to the North Carolina counties designated under a major disaster declaration by the President of the United States under the Stafford Act (P.L. 93-288) as a result of Hurricane Florence.

**Rationale:** Session Law 2019-224 redirects \$1,500,000 of the \$5 million was appropriated in Session Law 2018-136 for community college repair and renovation of college facilities damaged by Hurricane Florence and appropriates an additional \$4,900,000 to provide a total of \$6,400,000 to be allocated by the State Board of Community Colleges to offset the full-time equivalent (FTE) losses at affected colleges due to enrollment declines caused by Hurricane Florence.

**Method of Allocation:** Each community college allocation is based upon the FTE losses due to Hurricane Florence as reported by each college in March 2019 and is pro-rated to remain within the total \$6,400,000 appropriation. The table below provides the allocation amount for each college.
