

**STATE BOARD OF COMMUNITY COLLEGES**  
**Final Approval for Multi-Campus Center Designations**

**Request:** The State Board of Community Colleges is requested to provide final approval to the following campuses as Multi-Campus Centers (MCCs):

- Forsyth Technical Community College: Transportation Technology Center (4255 North Patterson Ave) – preliminary approval granted October 21, 2016.
- Guilford Technical Community College: Aviation Center (adjacent to Piedmont Triad International Airport) – preliminary approval granted November 16, 2018.
- Richmond Community College: Scotland County Campus (600 McLean Street) – preliminary approval granted November 17, 2017.
- Wake Technical Community College: RTP Campus (10908 Chapel Hill Road) – preliminary approval granted September 18, 2015.

**Background and Rationale:** Previously, the State Board granted preliminary approval to designate the above-referenced campuses as MCC locations. These preliminary approvals were contingent on the General Assembly appropriating additional funds to support the MCCs. Senate Bill 61 enacted as Session Law 2019-235 on November 1, 2019, includes funds for these locations, thus satisfying this contingency. Also, Guilford Technical Community College and Forsyth Technical Community College have each satisfied the additional contingency of submitting the SACS-COC approval letters. Richmond Community College has satisfied its additional contingency for final approval by receiving approval from the Scotland County Commissioners to transfer the ownership of Covington Street Elementary School to the college and completion of the college purchase of the Morgan Center.
