

**STATE BOARD OF COMMUNITY COLLEGES  
Allocation for 2015-2016 Minority Male Mentoring Program Grants**

**Request:** The State Board of Community Colleges is asked to approve an allocation of \$809,968 to forty-six community colleges for the Minority Male Mentoring Program for the 2015-16 academic year.

**Background:** The NC Minority Male Mentoring Program was established in the fall of 2003, using 6 pilot programs to improve retention and graduation rates. In fiscal year 2014-15 there were 46 programs statewide. Since inception, the program has received \$5,469,580.

**Rationale:** The intent of these allocations is to provide competitive grants that assist colleges with retention and graduation for at-risk minority male students through academic coaching, personal counseling, and professional growth and development. Funding for colleges will be provided as follows:

- Each college selected will receive a total amount of \$17,608.

Grant recipients will be required to expend funds within four areas: faculty and counselor support, general operating cost, student support wages (peer tutors, study ambassadors, etc.), and student development activities.

**Method of Allocation:** During 2015, a request for proposals was forwarded to all 58 community colleges. A committee of three, consisting of representatives from the System Office, reviewed and equitably selected colleges to receive funding. The proposals were scored on the following criteria: 1) needs and challenges, 2) program objectives, 3) implementation strategies, 4) anticipated benefits, 5) evaluation, dissemination, and replication, and 6) budget plan.

**Fund Source and Availability:** \$809,968 is contingent upon the FY2015-2016 State General Fund appropriation.

**Time Period:** The time frame for these Minority Male Mentoring Program grants is from July 1, 2015 to June 30, 2016.
