

**STATE BOARD OF COMMUNITY COLLEGES**  
**Construction and Property**

**1. Project Approval – New**

Pitt Community College – Project No. 2037 – Science Building. Estimated cost is \$18,000,000, composed of all local funds. **(NOTE: President Ralls, under the authority granted to him by the State Board, approved this project December 11, 2013.)**

**2. Acquisition and Disposal of Real Property**

- A. The Board of Trustees of Asheville-Buncombe Technical Community College request permission as per G.S. 115D-20 to acquire approximately 3.15 acres of property located contiguous to the main campus. **(NOTE: President Ralls, under the authority granted to him by the State Board, approved this project December 2, 2013.)**
- B. The Board of Trustees of Carteret Community College request permission as per G.S. 115D-20 to acquire by donation approximately .5 acres of property located between Arendell Street and Banks Street in Morehead City, North Carolina, adjacent to college property.
- C. The Board of Trustees of Haywood Community College request permission as per G.S. 115D-15 to dispose of approximately .51 acres of property with a house located at 224 Rush Road, Clyde, North Carolina. The Board of Trustees has determined the property and house are unnecessary and undesirable for the college purposes. **(NOTE: President Ralls, under the authority granted to him by the State Board, approved this project November 7, 2013.)**
- D. The Board of Trustees of Lenoir Community College request permission as per G.S. 115D-15 to dispose of approximately 2.81 acres of property and a building of approximately 7,718 square feet located at 818 Highway 91 North, Snow Hill, North Carolina. The Board of Trustees has determined the property and building are unnecessary and undesirable for the college purposes.
- E. The Board of Trustees of Mitchell Community College request permission as per G.S. 115D-20 to acquire approximately .28 acres of property with a two story brick house approximately 2,380 square feet with carport located at 116 North Race Street, Statesville, North Carolina. **(NOTE: President Ralls, under the authority granted to him by the State Board, approved this project November 14, 2013.)**
