

**STATE BOARD OF COMMUNITY COLLEGES**  
**Construction Delegation Request**  
**FY 2021-22**

**Request:** The Board of Trustees of Fayetteville Technical Community College requests permission as per G.S. 115D-9 to receive special construction delegation authority. The College understands and accepts the responsibilities of assuming an increase of delegation for capital improvement projects and knows they continue to be subject to all other statutes and rules governing community college capital improvement projects.

**Background:** GS 115D-9 authorizes the State Board of Community Colleges to delegate special authority to colleges to manage the following categories of capital improvement projects:

- Projects funded in part of in total with State funds requiring the total estimated expenditure of public funds of \$4,000,000 or less; and
- Projects funded in total with non-State funds regardless of the project's estimated cost.

On January 17, 2012, the State Board of Community Colleges approved revisions to the special construction delegation guidelines for colleges seeking approval.

**Conditions of Approval:** A college that is granted special construction delegation authority must agree to maintain a level of staffing, legal representation, and professional expertise that is consistent with what was represented on its special construction delegation application. If for any reason the college cannot maintain such a level, the college must notify the Director of Capital Finance and Planning at the System Office prior to initiating any new projects under their special construction delegation.
